Hello and welcome to our newsletter. It's been a busy summer at Ludgate. Skibbereen has been immersed with visitors, gold medals and film crew.



LUDGATE'S 5 YEAR ANNIVERSARY.

Ludgate is celebrating it's five year anniversary.

In 2016 Skibbereen was selected as a pilot town by SIRO, a joint venture company between ESB and Vodafone to deliver a 100% fibre-to-the-building broadband network, to install for the first time in an Irish rural town IGB of internet connectivity. Five years on and Ludgate is thriving. Since opening in July 2016 we have welcomed more than 3500 hot desks, been a base for more than 63 companies. Our community benefits to date include 8 Social Enterprises 40+ Coderdojo Kids, 40 Silver Surfers, 50 girls in Code for Girls and 19 pilot schools programmes through our education pillar. Ludgate is also one of the founding members of the ITHN. The network brings together Ireland's best-in-class tech hubs who have significant potential to catalyse innovation in their region.

In 2020 we opened a second location in the centre of town, Ludgate@fields offering 8 private offices that can be rented on a daily/weekly and monthly basis. Plans for our next location at the Old Mercy Heights School are also underway. The team at Ludgate would like to extend a heartfelt thank you to everyone who made Ludgate possible, on its 5 Year Anniversary.


